

Designing Curriculum Adaptable to Different Classroom Settings

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We designed a K-12 User Centered Design (UCD) Curriculum that is adaptable to different classroom settings, easy to pick up by new teachers, makes it easy to contribute by other instructors and easy to share (based on curriculum shared at <http://bit.ly/hcdeatchi2018>)

Adaptable to New Classrooms

Design curriculum so that is easy to adapt to new classrooms with different needs.

E.g. Design challenges appropriate for different student groups and interests

Facilitates Transferability

Create curriculum structure that is easy to pick up by new instructors.

E.g. Include facilitation notes, where students get stuck, prep instructions, etc

Facilitates Participation

Design curriculum so that it is easy for other instructor to embed new content

E.g. Make different curriculum elements easy to swap in and out

Sharing Infrastructure

Share content through infrastructure that makes it easy to remix and edit

E.g. Use a platform for hosting materials that are meant for participation and editing content, like Google Docs
